One-Page Guide

1 What is it an expert group in the CPMS?

- Expert groups in the CPMS (also called **Virtual Boards**) are groups of experts regularly meeting in the CPMS to provide advice on complex cases of very rare haematological diseases.
- There are currently 2 expert groups established :
 - **Cutaneous Lymphoma Virtual Board**
 - **Rare Haemolytic Anemias Virtual Board**

2 Who can become a member of an expert group?

- Members of the ERN-EuroBloodNet or Guest Members established in the EU.
- Health Professionals from different disciplines with expertise in a specific rare haematological disease.

3 How to settle an expert group?

- Contact the **CPMS Helpdesk** to identify voluntary experts among the ERN-EuroBloodNet
- Once the list of experts established, the Helpdesk will settle the group within the CPMS

4 Invite an expert group to a panel:

Once the Helpdesk has set up the Expert Group, the option to invite Groups will be displayed at the top of the Available tab.

1. Use the **Invite a Expert Group** drop-down to select an Expert Group: The list of Health Professionals in the group will be displayed.
2. Click the **Invite Expert Group** button at the top of the list of Health Professional to send an invitation to all members of the Group.
 - o The invited participants will receive an email notification of the panel invitation.

5 Invite an expert group to a meeting:

1. **Select the Expert Group** from the drop-down list.
2. Use the **Invite Expert Group** button above the list health professionals in the group to invite them to the meeting: A confirmation that invited participants have been sent an email notification of the meeting invitation will be displayed
